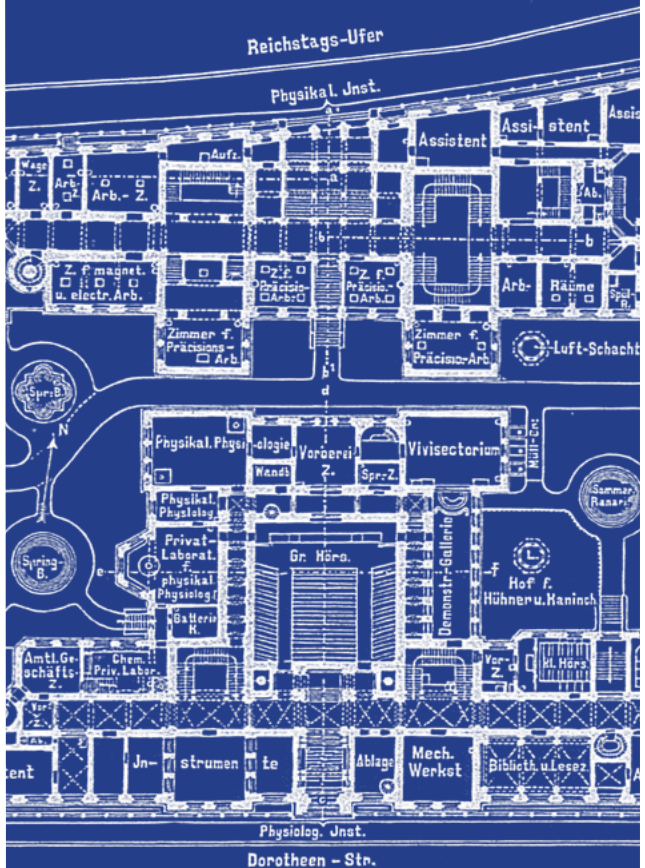

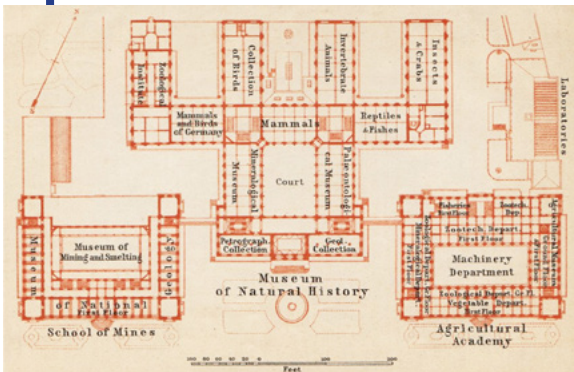


Prince Heinrich Palais (HU main building)

For about three centuries, buildings of science have shaped the urban face of Berlin. Initially it was the buildings of the Academy of Sciences and the Charité, but from the early 19th century to the present day the universities have had a decisive influence on the appearance of the city. The interweaving of the modern scientific landscape with the development of a European metropolis from enlightened absolutism to the present is condensed in the architectural heritage.

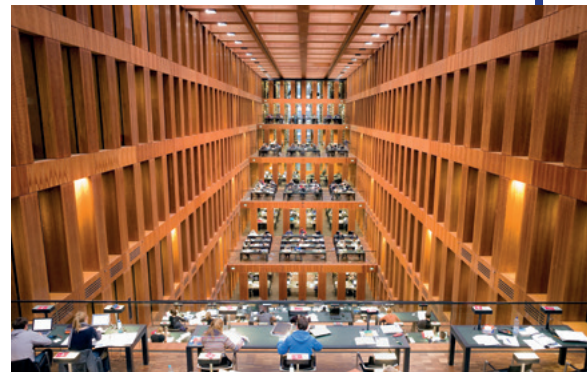
